



Organized by the Institute for Nuclear Research, under the auspices of the Romanian Academy and in cooperation with University of Pitesti, Academy of Romanian Scientists and Technical Sciences Academy of Romania, NUCLEAR2020 joins the national, European and international efforts to promote and support the benefits of nuclear energy in mitigating the climate change and its synergistic role in the energy mix and in ensuring energy security.

In this context, Nuclear 2020 particularly aims to:

- promote the role and contribution of the nuclear energy in achieving the climate goals;
- promote the most recent and valuable results of nuclear research and education;
- strengthen the collaboration among research, academia, nuclear industry and business environment at national, European and international level;
- reflect on the national nuclear engineering and research and their social relevance.

Every year, the Conference attracts around 250 participants from Romania and abroad. The invitation is open but not limited to nuclear scientists, professionals, and academia, as well as to representatives of nuclear industry, regulators, local and national authorities, Romanian Government, European Commission and international organizations.

A large participation of young researchers and students is highly encouraged and aimed in supporting the overall efforts for talents attraction in the nuclear field.

Structure

NUCLEAR2020 includes plenary sessions, parallel sessions (oral and poster), round tables and technical visits to the experimental facilities of the Institute for Nuclear Research - recently designated by IAEA as an International Centre based on Research Reactor (ICERR): the TRIGA Reactor and the Hot Cells.

Special Event

Exceptionally, this edition will organize a session entitled “**Nuclear energy and the society**”, jointly with the Committee on History and Philosophy of Science and Technology (CRIFST) of the Romanian Academy. The session precedes the celebration of the 50th anniversary of RATEN ICN and targets to address the interface between science/new technologies and the public, the most recent innovations and trends in nuclear energy, and the challenges faced in the knowledge management.

Awards

The Conference features two categories of awards:

- 1. Nuclear 2020 Award** – for the best 3 papers produced by researchers below 35 years old
- 2. Nuclear 2020 Student Award** – for Master and Bachelor thesis presented during the Conference, in the Session dedicated to students in nuclear field.

Venue

The Conference is hosted by the Institute for Nuclear Research at their premises in Mioveni, town located at about 25 km North from Pitesti, on the national road Pitesti - Brasov. The closest airport is Henri Coanda - Otopeni, Bucharest (115 km to Pitesti, freeway access).

From Bucharest, Pitesti can be reached by car - on freeway A1, or by train - every 2 hours from Bucharest North Railway Station (Gara de Nord), or by bus - almost every 30 min. from Militari Bus Station.

At request, the Organizing Committee can assist foreign participants with the transfer from the airport to Pitesti.

The transport from Pitesti to Mioveni will be provided by the Institute for Nuclear Research.
