NUCLEAR 2019 - the Annual International Conference Sustainable Development through Nuclear Research and Education, organized and hosted by the Institute for Nuclear Research Pitești-Mioveni will take place on June 3-4. It will be in connection the FISA2019 and EURADWASTE '19 - the 9th European Commission Conferences on EURATOM Research and Training in Safety of Reactor and Radioactive Waste Management, co-organized by the European Commission and the Romanian Presidency of the Council of the European Union on June 4-7, 2019 in Pitești.

In this particular context, Nuclear 2019 aims to:

- review the participation of Member States in the Framework Programmes FP7 and H2020 and assess the relevance for the priorities and actual needs of the national R&D programmes.
- to present the major national projects in the nuclear research, education and industry, and share the challenges in their implementation.

The invitation is open to the European nuclear research community, industry, policy makers, safety authorities and academia.

Contribution, expected from both New and Old Member States, will set the base for discussions in the view of future collaborations at regional and European level, both in the promotion of the relevant topics as well as in implementation of specific projects.

Special Event: Students' Poster session

The 3rd Students Poster Session will continue to reflect on the Romanian efforts for the education and training of future scientists in the nuclear field. The most valuable 3 posters will be awarded during FISA2019 and EURADWASTE '19 Conference Dinner.

Structure

Exceptionally, NUCLEAR 2019 will be only a 2-day conference, with a plenary session on June 3rd, focused on the Euratom programme and the major national nuclear R&D priorities and projects, and Student Poster and Awards on June 4th, jointly with FISA and EURADWASTE.

Venue

The Conference is hosted by the Institute for Nuclear Research at their premises in Mioveni, town located at about 25 km North from Pitești, on the national road Pitești - Brașov. The closest airport is Henri Coanda - Otopeni, Bucharest (115 km to Pitești, freeway access).

From Bucharest, Pitești can be reached by car - on freeway A1, or by train - every 2 hours from Bucharest North Railway Station (Gara de Nord), or by bus - almost every 30 min. from Militari Bus Station.

At request, the Organizing Committee can assist foreign participants with the transfer from the airport to Pitești.

The transport from Pitești to Mioveni will be provided by the Institute for Nuclear Research.
